- B. God promises to send a Redeemer (vs. 15) Genesis 3:15 - And I will put enmity Between you and the woman, And between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head, And you shall bruise His heel.

C. God provides a suitable covering (vs. 21) Genesis 3:21 - Also for Adam and his wife the Lord God made tunics of skin, and clothed them.
