

5/5/24 Text: Genesis 9:18-29

"A Covering for Shame"

1. A re-created world (vs. 18-20).

[18] The sons of Noah who went forth from the ark were Shem, Ham, and Japheth. (Ham was the father of Canaan.) [19] These three were the sons of Noah, and from these the people of the whole earth were dispersed. [20] Noah began to be a man of the soil, and he planted a vineyard.

2. A foolish failure (vs. 21).

[21] He drank of the wine and became drunk and lay uncovered in his tent.

3. A disgraceful desecration (vs. 22).

[22] And Ham, the father of Canaan, saw the nakedness of his father and told his two brothers outside.

4. A righteous response (vs. 23).

[23] Then Shem and Japheth took a garment, laid it on both their shoulders, and walked backward and covered the nakedness of their father. Their faces were turned backward, and they did not see their father's nakedness.

*1 Peter 4:8; Genesis 3:21; Psalm 32:1

5. A curse and a blessing (vs. 24-29).

[24] When Noah awoke from his wine and knew what his youngest son had done to him, [25] he said,

"Cursed be Canaan;

a servant of servants shall he be to his brothers."

[26] He also said,

"Blessed be the LORD, the God of Shem;

and let Canaan be his servant.

[27] May God enlarge Japheth,

and let him dwell in the tents of Shem,

and let Canaan be his servant."

[28] After the flood Noah lived 350 years. [29] All the days of Noah were 950 years, and he died.
